

Learning in Complex Systems (049004) Guidelines for Final Requirements

1. Paper Summary

You are requested to submit a short summary and critical overview of a journal paper (or papers). Guidelines will be available on the course site.

Submission date: Up to Monday, 1/8/11.

2. Class Presentation of an Application Paper

Presentation guidelines: You are required to present in class an article that deals with an application of RL, ADP or SA. The presentation should be up to 20 minutes long (excluding time for questions). A typical presentation will describe the problem (including special features and difficulties), the selected solution, the obtained results, and a critical evaluation. Please hand over to me a hardcopy of your slides during the presentation.

Paper choice: You may choose the paper to be presented from the list published on the course site, or suggest another paper. Suggested papers should generally be journal papers or published in a major conference (ICML, NIPS etc.). In any case the paper should be approved by me. Please e-mail me your choice by 3/7/11. Also mention your preferred presentation date.

Note: Papers that were already taken by other students will be indicated on the site. To avoid iterations, it is advisable to send me two choices in order of preference.

Dates: We will have two meetings of about 2 hours. You are required to attend both. Scheduled to: 18/7, 1/8 (Monday, 16:30-18:30),
